

How to Create an HSQ Technology Screen Saver

To create a flying, three dimensional HSQ logo screen saver, you must have *one* of the following operating systems loaded on your PC:

- The Windows 95 or Windows 98 operating system. This requires that a separate software package, Microsoft Plus 95/98, also be installed.
- The Windows NT operating system (which already includes the necessary graphics software for creating the screen saver).

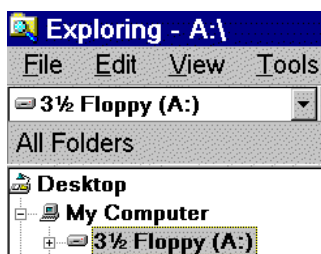
In addition, you will need the following:

- The desired HSQ logo bitmap graphic. If this does not exist on your machine, then it must be transferred from the HSQ-provided disk to the correct Windows directory on your hard drive. For details of this procedure, see the following section, **Transferring a File to the Local Hard Drive**.

Transferring a File to the Local Hard Drive

To transfer the desired bitmap graphic(s) from a floppy diskette to the local hard drive, perform the following steps:

1. Insert the floppy diskette containing the HSQ bitmap graphic(s) into the local diskette drive.
2. Open the **Windows Explorer** by right-clicking on the **Start** button at the bottom left-hand corner of the screen. This will open a screen that lists all the drives, directories, sub-directories and files that your computer can “see.”
3. Highlight the floppy drive to select it. You may have to scroll the left-hand pane up to find the floppy drive.



This action will cause any files contained on the floppy diskette to appear in the right-hand pane of the Explorer window. Specifically, this should include both the **Hsq.bmp** and **HsqTV.bmp** graphics files.

4. Highlight the two graphic files located on the floppy diskette drive and right-click with the mouse. This will open a sub-menu that contains, among other things, the **Copy** command. Click the Copy command to copy the

two graphics files to the Windows clipboard.

5. Scroll the left-hand pane of the Explorer window until **My Computer** displays. (If your computer has been renamed, choose that instead.) If the directories underneath My Computer are not listed, double click it, to expand the directory structure.
6. Select (highlight) the following sub-directory under My Computer, depending on your computer's operating system:
 - **Windows 95/98** - Windows
 - **Windows NT** - WinNT
7. After highlighting the appropriate directory, right-click with the mouse.



Select the **Paste** command from the displayed sub-menu. This action will copy the contents of the Windows clipboard into the highlighted directory.

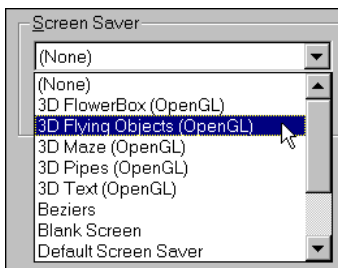
Setting Up the 3D Screen Saver

Perform the following steps to setup the HSQ Logo screen saver:

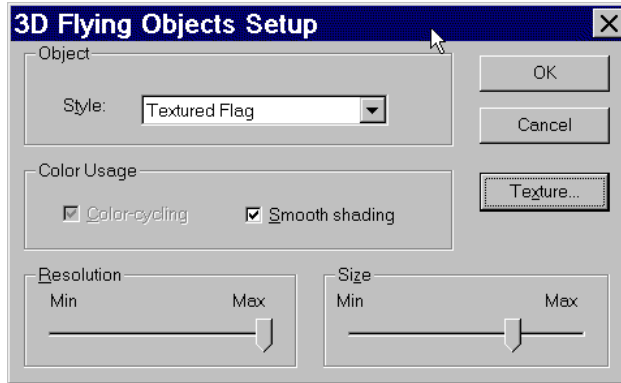
1. Call up the **Control Panel**. (This can be done from Start | Settings.)
2. Double-click on the **Display** icon to open the **Display Properties** dialog box.



3. In the **Screen Saver** tab, select **3D Flying Objects (OpenGL)** from the drop-down list.



4. Click the **Settings** push-button to open the **3D Flying Objects Setup** box.



5. In the **Style** drop-down list, ensure that **Textured Flag** object type is selected.
6. Click the **Texture** button. This action will open a standard Windows-style open file dialog box.

Browse to the appropriate directory and select either the Hsq.bmp or the HsqTV.bmp graphics file from the list of files. Click the **Open** button to close out of the **Choose Texture File** dialog box.

Click the **OK** button to close the **Setup** dialog box. (You may set the other parameters as desired.)

7. Click the **Apply** button (in the Screen Saver tab) and then the **OK** button (in the Display Properties dialog box).
8. Close the **Control Panel** window, if it is still open.
